**Dear SRBA Family**, I regularly listen to a podcast on church revitalization and replanting. Recently, a staggering statistic caught my attention: excluding church plants, less than 3% of SBC churches have experienced evangelical growth this past year—growth measured by salvation, not just "sheep swapping."

The commentator noted that many churches have lost their evangelistic zeal—becoming more focused on internal care than on reaching their "Jerusalems, Judeas, and the uttermost parts" as Jesus commanded (Acts 1:8).

#### Southern Baptist Convention Recap

Earlier this month, Rhonda and I had the opportunity to attend the **Southern Baptist Convention in Dallas**, **Texas**, participating in **three separate gatherings over five days**.

#### 1. SBCAL Preconference

The Southern Baptist Conference of Associational Leaders (SBCAL) hosted a 1.5-day preconference with the theme: "The Fruitful Strategist" based on *Titus* 3:14 –

"And let our people also learn to maintain good works, to meet urgent needs, that they may not be unfruitful."

#### 2. SBC Pastors' Conference

Next came the **Pastors' Conference** themed **"Worth Following**," where faithful preachers exposited the book of 2 *Timothy*. These sermons are available on YouTube under "SBC Pastors Conference 2025."

#### 3. The SBC Convention

This year's theme was "Hold Fast" from Hebrews 10:23-25 -

"Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful..."

There was a genuine **spirit of unity**, which is not always the case at these gatherings! As the saying goes, "What do you get when two Baptists gather? Three opinions."

We also celebrated the 100th anniversary of the Cooperative Program and the Baptist Faith and Message. These two "rails" continue to guide our shared mission:

• The Baptist Faith and Message anchors us in sound doctrine and biblical faithfulness.
